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Progress to 10% by 2010

- The first UK Government target on renewable energy

Actual Progress

- 4.5% of UK electricity supplies currently generated from renewables (1.5% from wind energy and 3% non-wind renewables - mainly hydro)

Getting to 2010

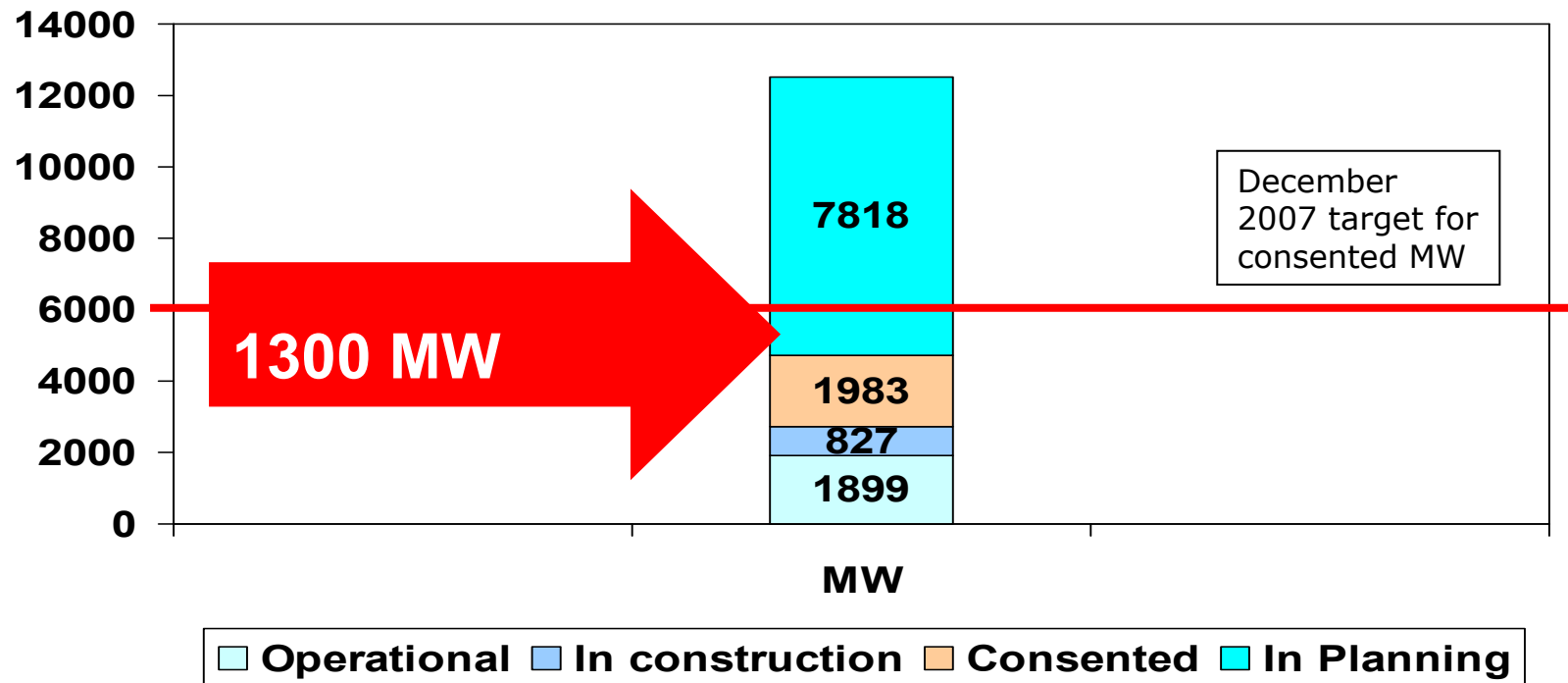
- By 2010 non-wind renewables expected to contribute 4% and offshore wind 1.5% totalling 5.5%
- **Onshore wind is required to deliver 4.5% of UK electricity by 2010**

Progress to 4.5% Onshore Wind

- 4.5% electricity from onshore wind =
6,000 MW installed from approx 3,600 turbines

How close are we?

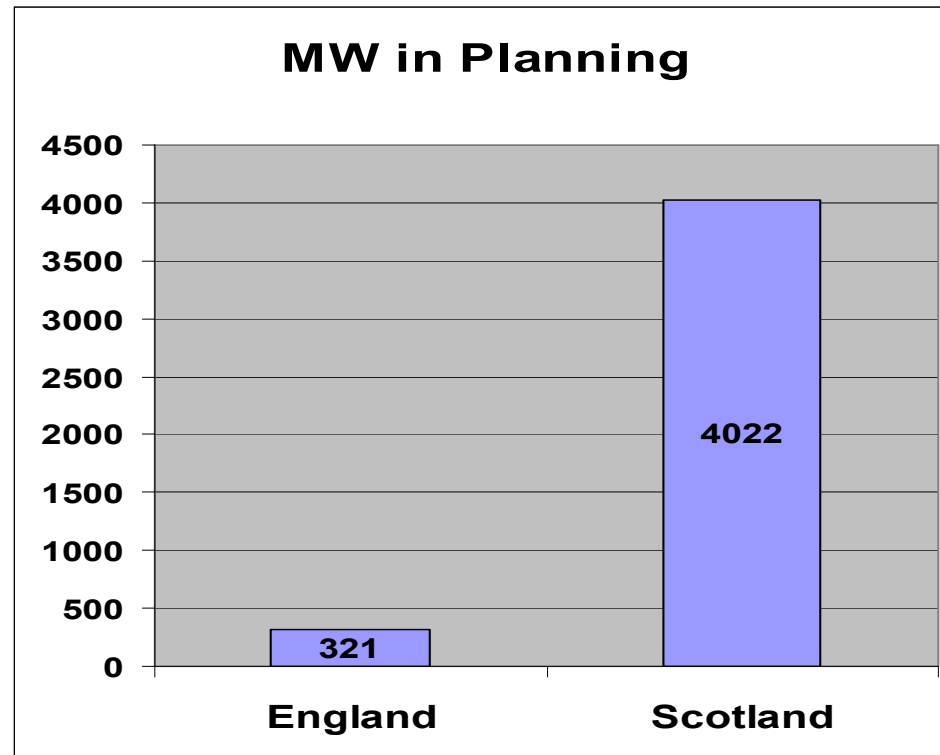
Progress to 6,000 MW Onshore Wind



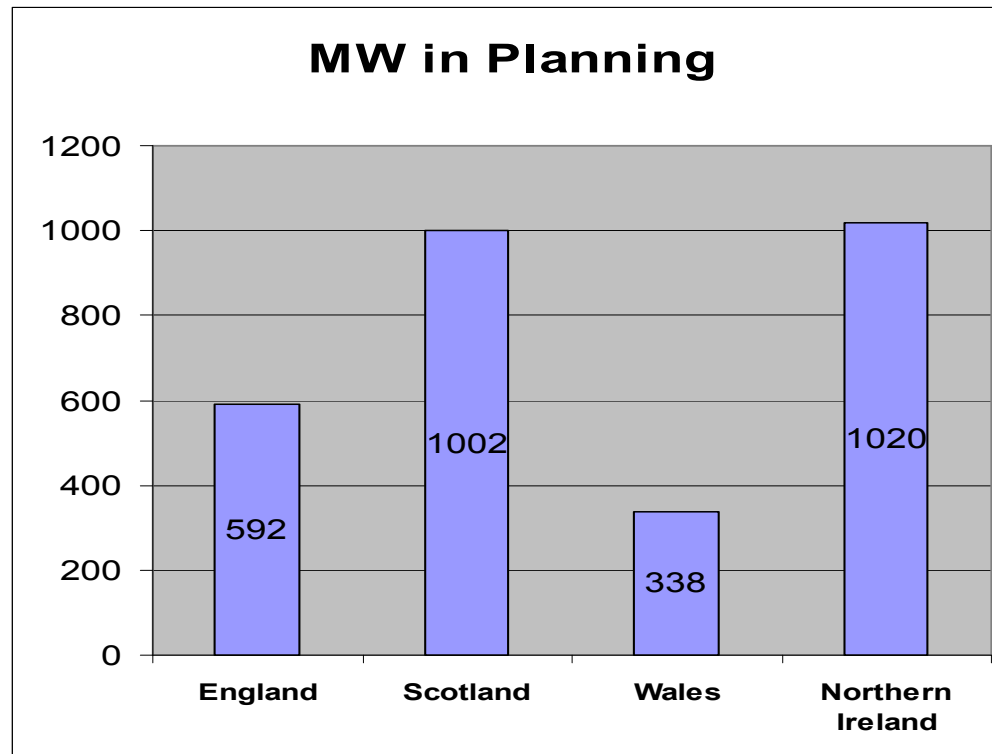
Mind the gap

- 1,300 MW short of onshore wind consents
- 8,000 MW in the planning system
- One sixth of the capacity in planning to be determined in the next few months

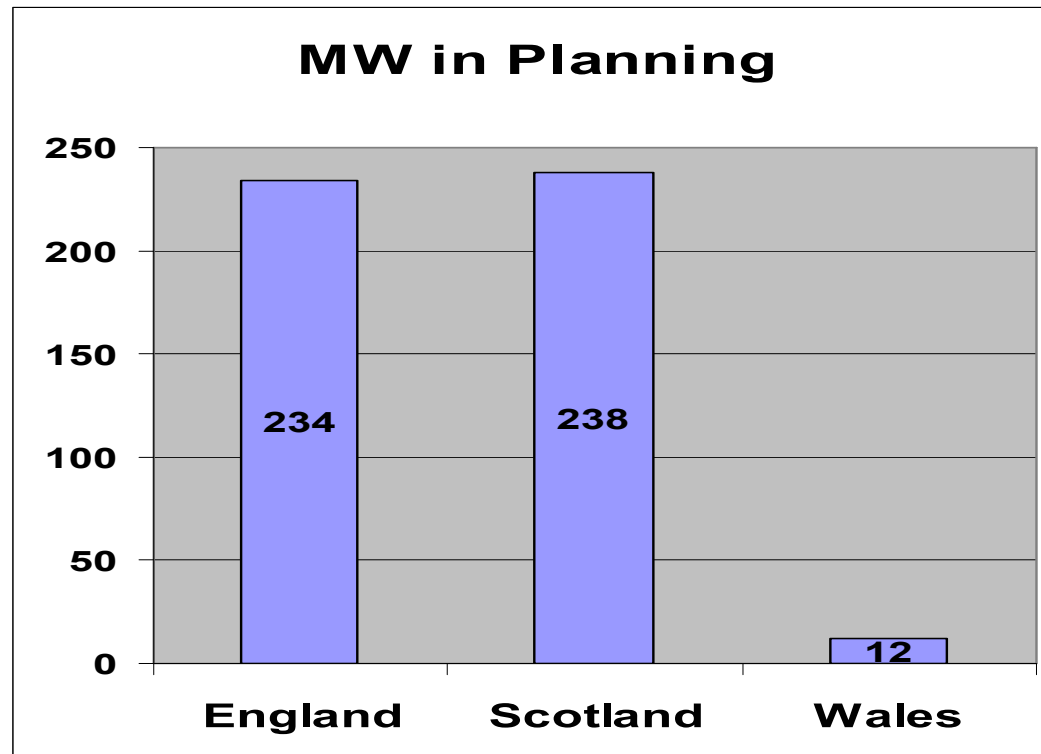
